

This student tutorial provides steps for joining a class in ELEteca, the learning management system for Cambridge Spanish materials.

NOTE: In order to join a class, you must have both a student code and a class enrollment code. Ask your teacher for the correct class enrollment code.

1. Before you can join a class, you must first activate contents using a student code:

2. On the **My digital contents/ My courses** screen, select **Class Enrollment Code** and enter the code in the field below:
